It raises all who were kings of the nations from their thrones. ¹⁰ All of them will greet you, "You also have become weak like us! You have become like one of us!" ¹¹ Your pride has been brought down to Sheol along with the music of your harps. Maggots are spread out like a bed under you, and worms cover you. ¹² How you have fallen from heaven, you morning star, son of the dawn! How you have been cut down to the ground, you conqueror of nations! ¹³ You thought, "I'll go up to heaven and set up my throne above God's stars. I'll sit on the mountain far away in the north where the gods assemble. ¹⁴ I'll go above the top of the clouds. I'll be like the Most High." ¹⁵ But you've been brought down to Sheol, to the deepest part of the pit.
